- Passing details on to appropriate law enforcement bodies.

We regularly monitor our risks in this area, and we will continue to take action to embed a zero-tolerance policy towards modern slavery.

This policy was adopted in 2023 after being agreed by our senior management team and director, it is reviewed annually.
